Alpha uses the Church Engagement Framework (CEF) as a strategy that helps us as an organisation to focus on developing strategies to engage with churches on their journey of running Alpha effectively. The CEF is a 3-phase journey comprising Explore, Experience, and Extend.

The aim of Extend is to identify and equip Hub Churches* that are uniquely positioned to influence other churches and have the vision to help other churches to run Alpha.

*Hub Churches are churches that influence other churches within their geographical area, their denomination or their network. They run high-quality Alphas and have a vision to help other churches by providing 'Come and See' opportunities and dedicate their own people and resources to lead Hub Church work. Within the Extend journey, these Hub Churches come together in cohorts and play a key part in the growth of Alpha.
